

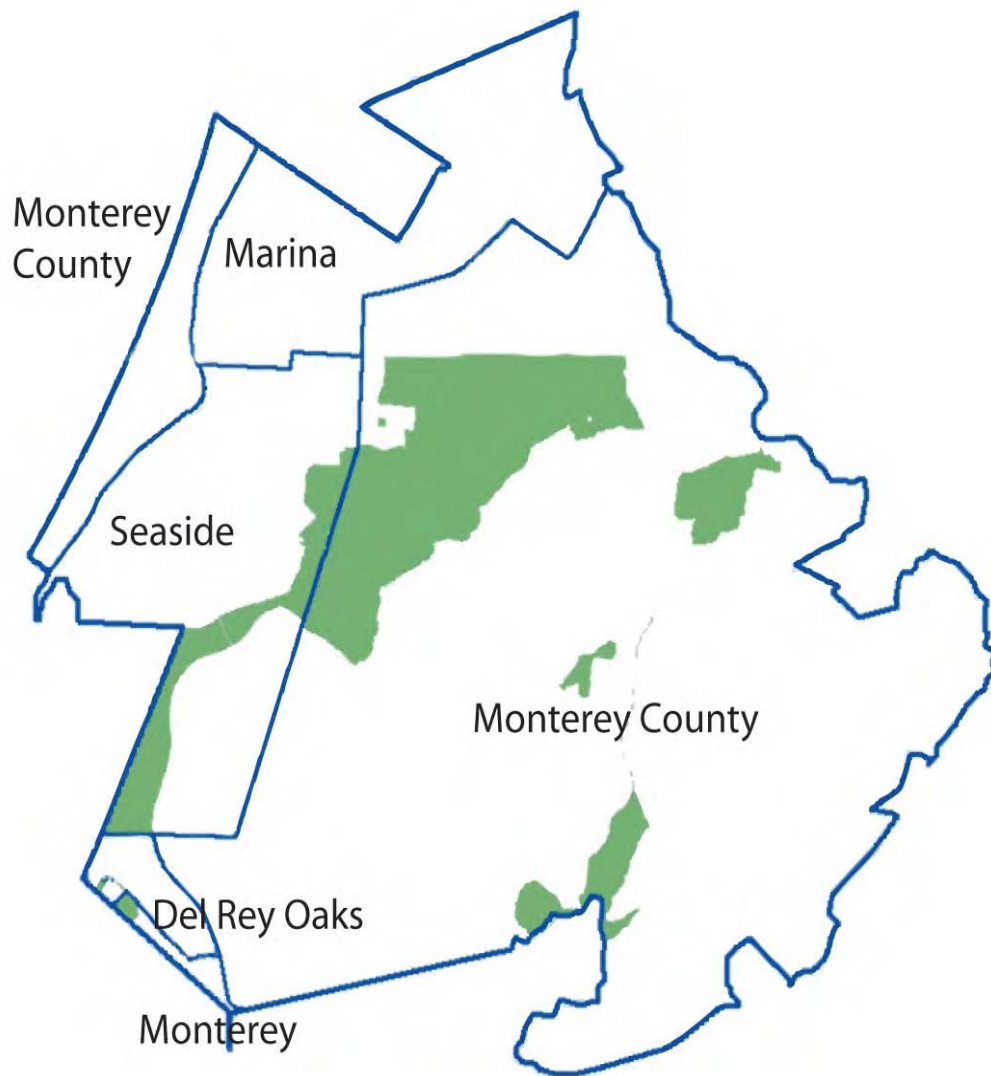

SCAs

- Historic/current fencing
- Asphalt/concrete range pads, roads and walkways
- Underneath existing structures
- Berms/culverts
- Heavy equipment excavation sites
- Debris piles



Completing Seaside 1-4

- In cooperation with the regulatory agencies FORA and its contractors will complete the work begun by the Army in Seaside 1-4: SCA
- FORA is developing an addendum to the Army Work Plan detailing completion work
- FORA will be enhancing the work by investigating the hillside area west of General Jim Moore Boulevard

Seaside 1-4 SCA Site Preparation

- Site preparation activities
 - Inspection
 - Install new fence/remove old
 - Debris, structure, asphalt and concrete removal
 - SCA boundary delineation
 - Vegetation cutting

- SCA soil removal and sifting
- Digital Geophysical Mapping
- Investigate mapped anomalies
- Anomaly Excavation
- Quality Control/Quality Assurance
- Documentation of Work Performed
