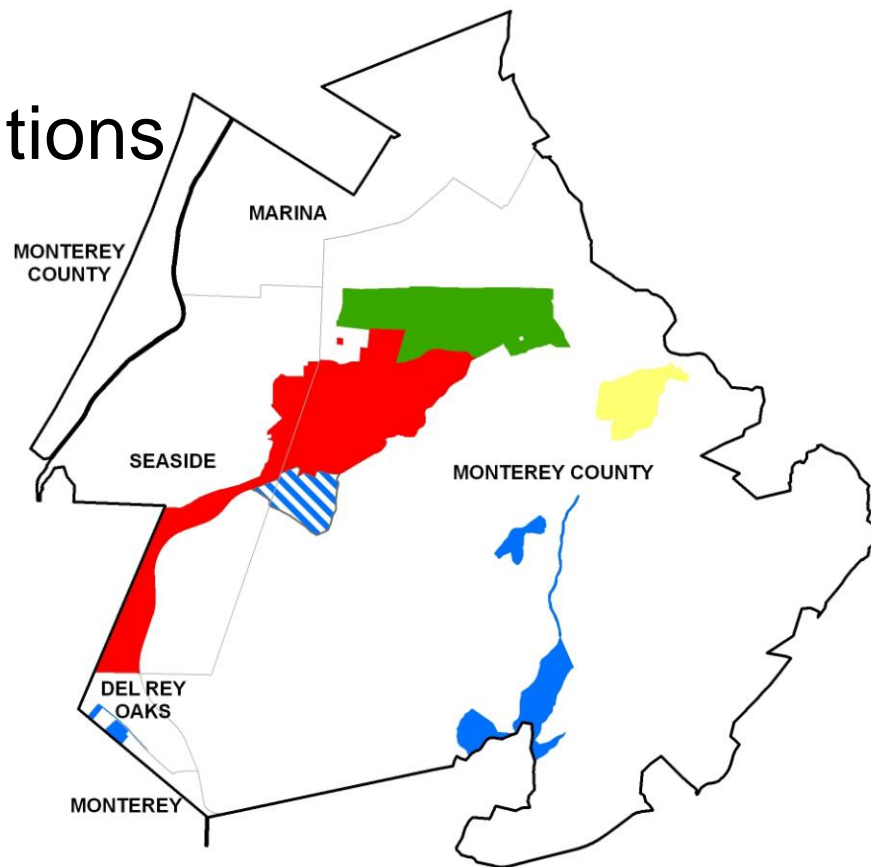

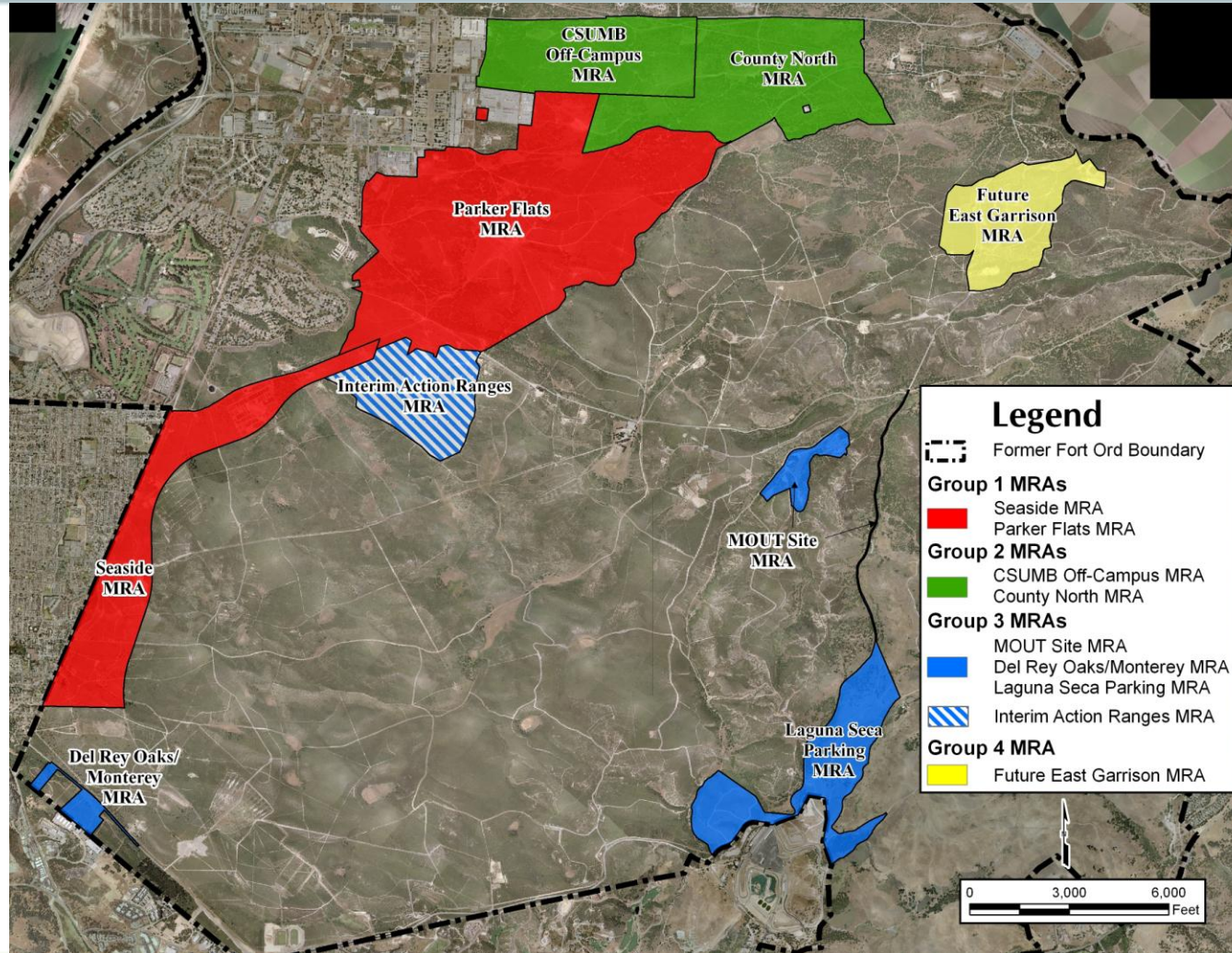

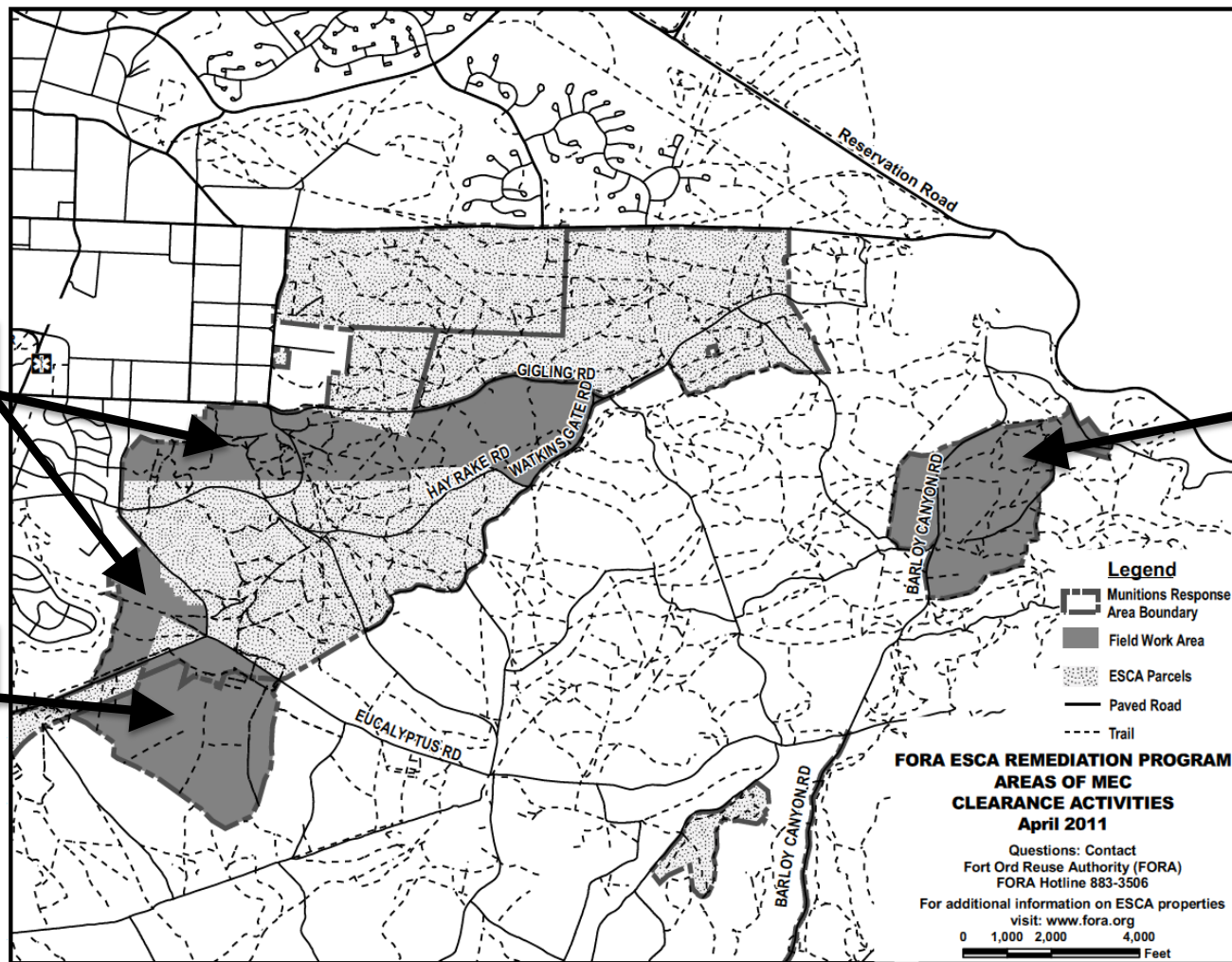
ESCA Munitions Response Areas by Group

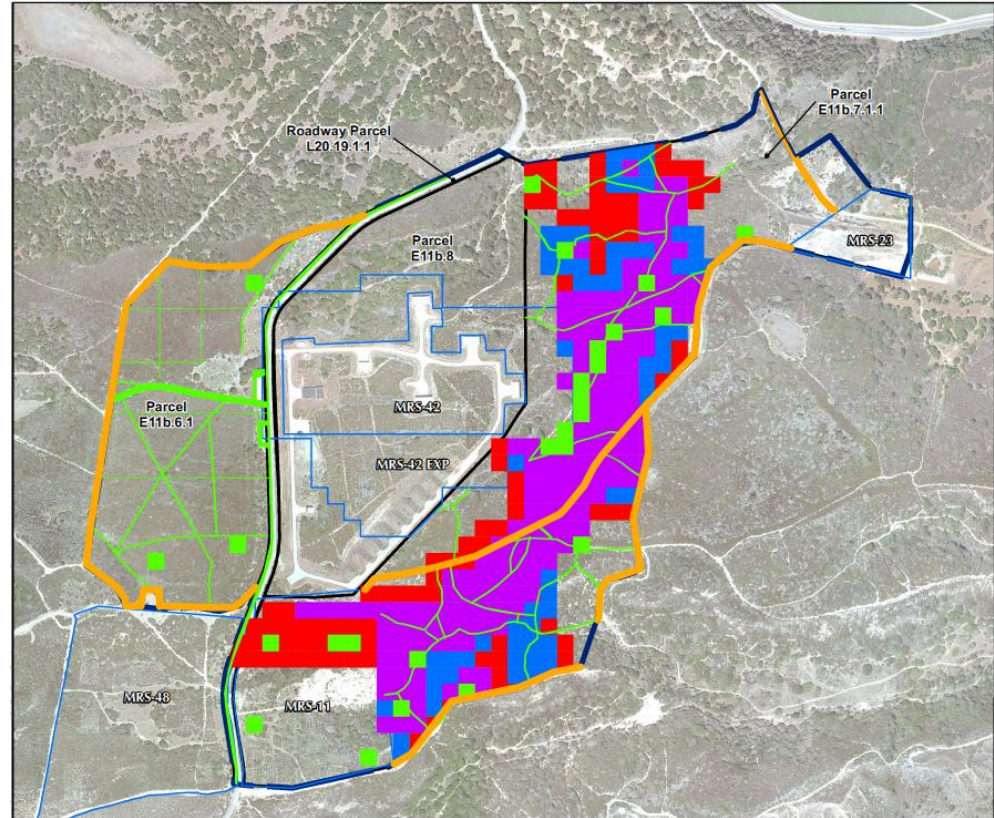

Future East Garrison MRA Update

- Final Work Plan published October 2010
- Vegetation cutting necessary
- Investigation began November 2010
- Investigation locations:
 - Biological monitoring transects
 - Existing trails and roadways
 - Select grids in habitat areas

Future East Garrison Investigation Area

- Development and habitat area parcels
- Biological profile collected
- MEC profile collected
- Evidence of munitions training in habitat area
- Investigation area-phased expansion
- Requires additional brush cutting-less than 50 acres of chaparral have been cut

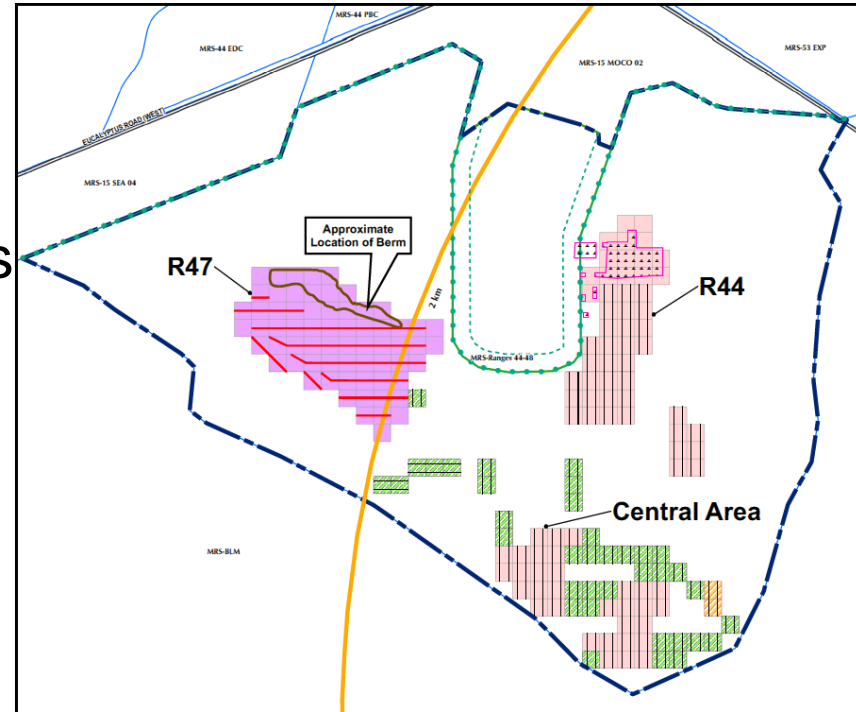


Future East Garrison MEC Finds



Interim Action Ranges MRA

- Habitat area
- Work Plan under review
- Vegetation removal necessary:
 - Define Munitions and Explosives of Concern (MEC) removal areas
 - Support completion of remedial action
- MEC removal:
 - Focused excavation & sifting
 - Follow-up with Digital Geophysical Mapping (DGM)
 - DGM other areas



Habitat Program Update

- Working under the Army's Biological Opinion
- Habitat Management Plan plants and animals in ESCA parcels
- Inventory sensitive plant populations and potential California Tiger Salamander breeding habitat
- Mitigation checklist helps avoid/minimize impacts
- Recovery and regeneration documented
- Data analysis determines compliance

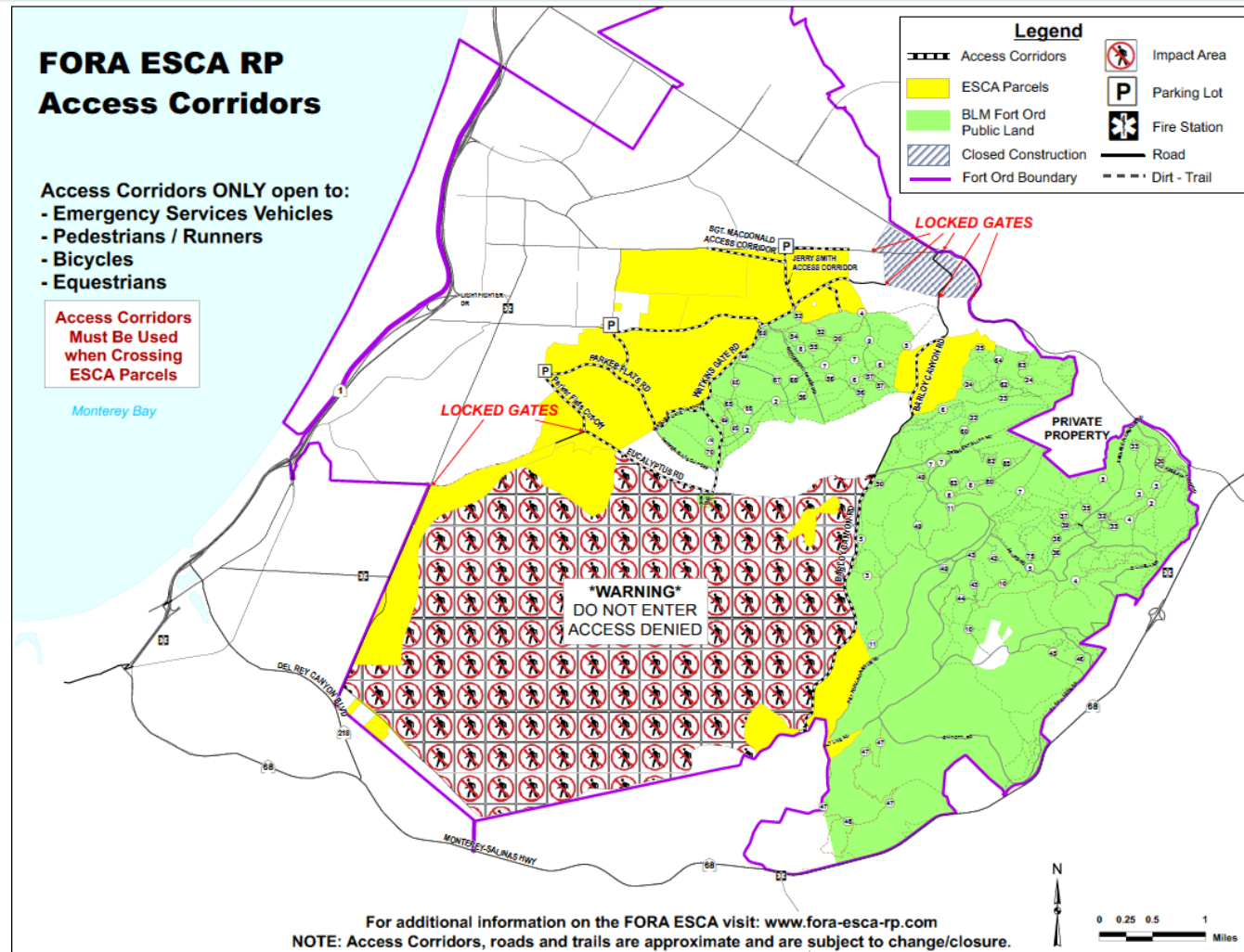

Staying Safe Around Mountain Lions

Mountain lions are quiet, solitary and elusive. They typically avoid people.

Should you come across a Mountain Lion:

- Stay calm.
- Do not run. This may trigger the lion's natural instinct to chase.
- Stand and face the lion.
- Make eye contact. Slowly and carefully back away.
- Do not yell. Talk calmly and firmly.
- Do not crouch or bend over.
- Do all you can to appear larger. Raise your arms and open your jacket.
- Control children so they don't run.
- Never approach a lion. Give them a way to escape.
- If attacked, fight back.
