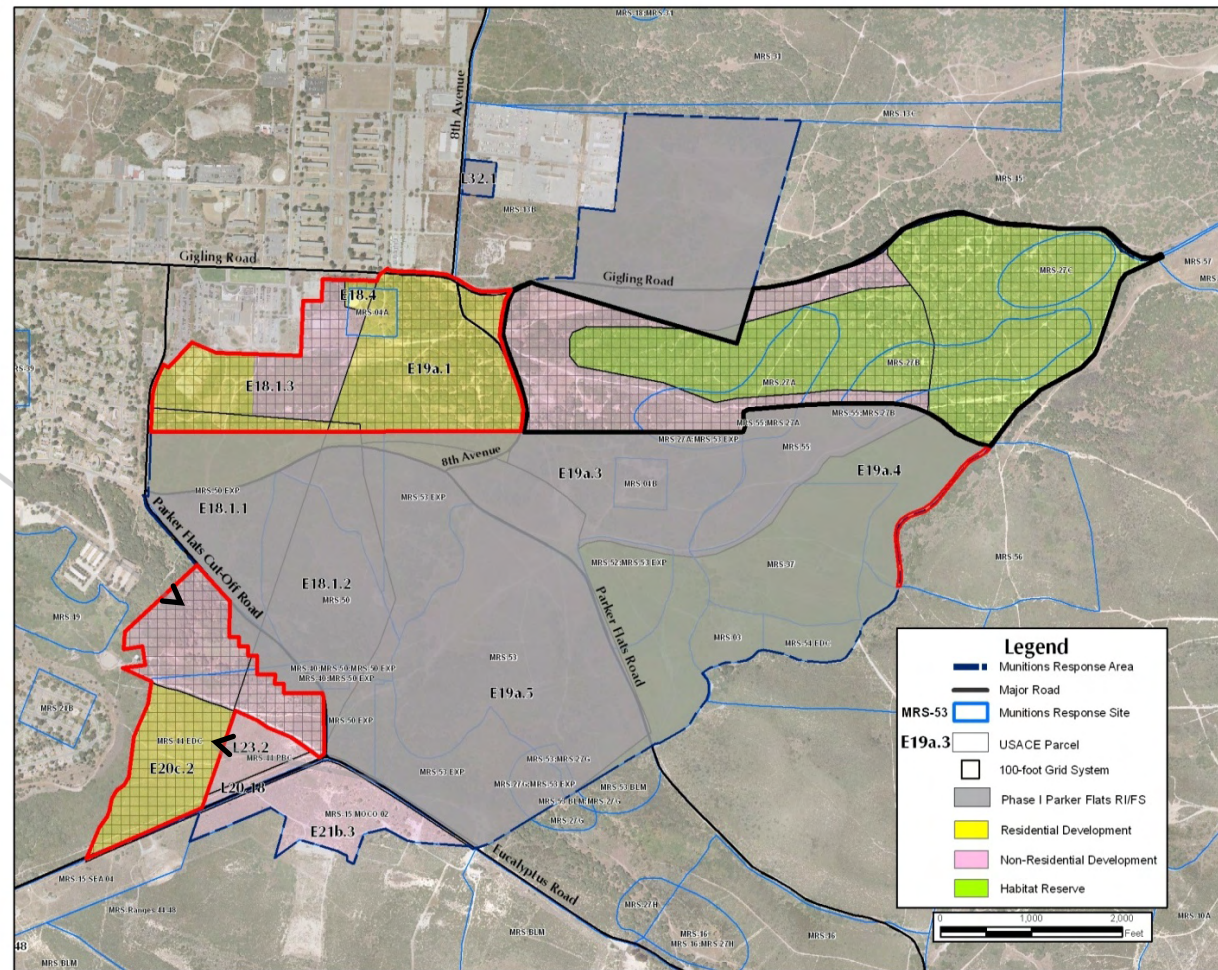


Seaside Update

- General Jim Moore Boulevard (GJMB) will be open for traffic in November 2010
- A fence has been installed on the east side of GJMB to maintain ESCA site security
- Next step for the ESCA - begin Residential Quality Assurance (RQA) Implementation Study

Update: Parker Flats

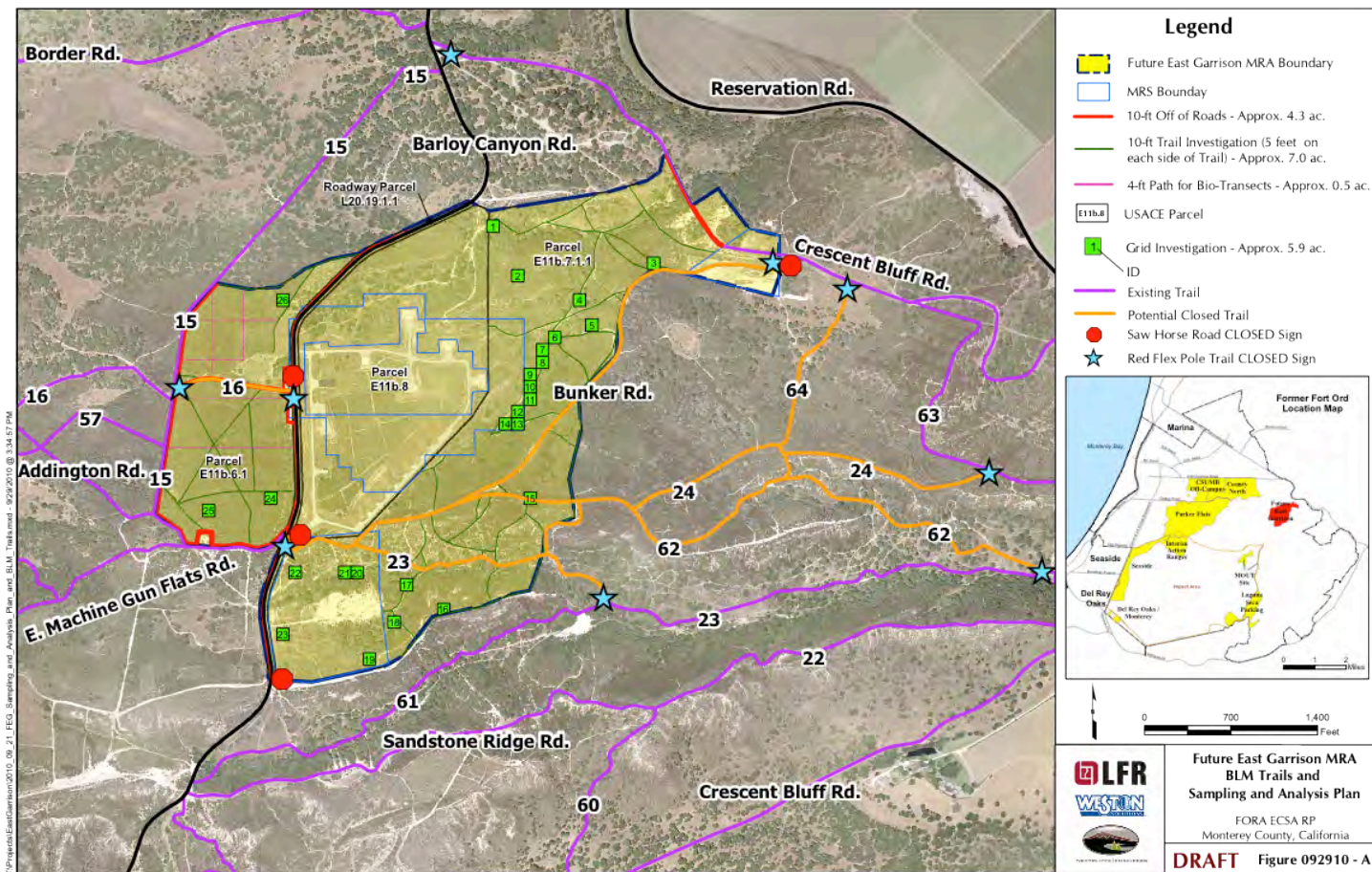
- Technicians recovered approximately:
 - 1,000 munitions and explosives of concern (MEC) items
 - 5,000 munitions debris items
- Finds are consistent with previous military training activities
- Next Steps:
 - RQA Implementation Study
 - Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) Report

Future East Garrison

- Final Group 4 RI/FS Work Plan
 - Approved October 2010
 - Identified need for additional data/investigation
- Current Field Work
 - Vegetation cutting for focused biological monitoring
 - MEC investigation in Habitat Areas
- What does this mean?
 - Area closed through 2012
 - For Your Safety – respect signs and stay out of area

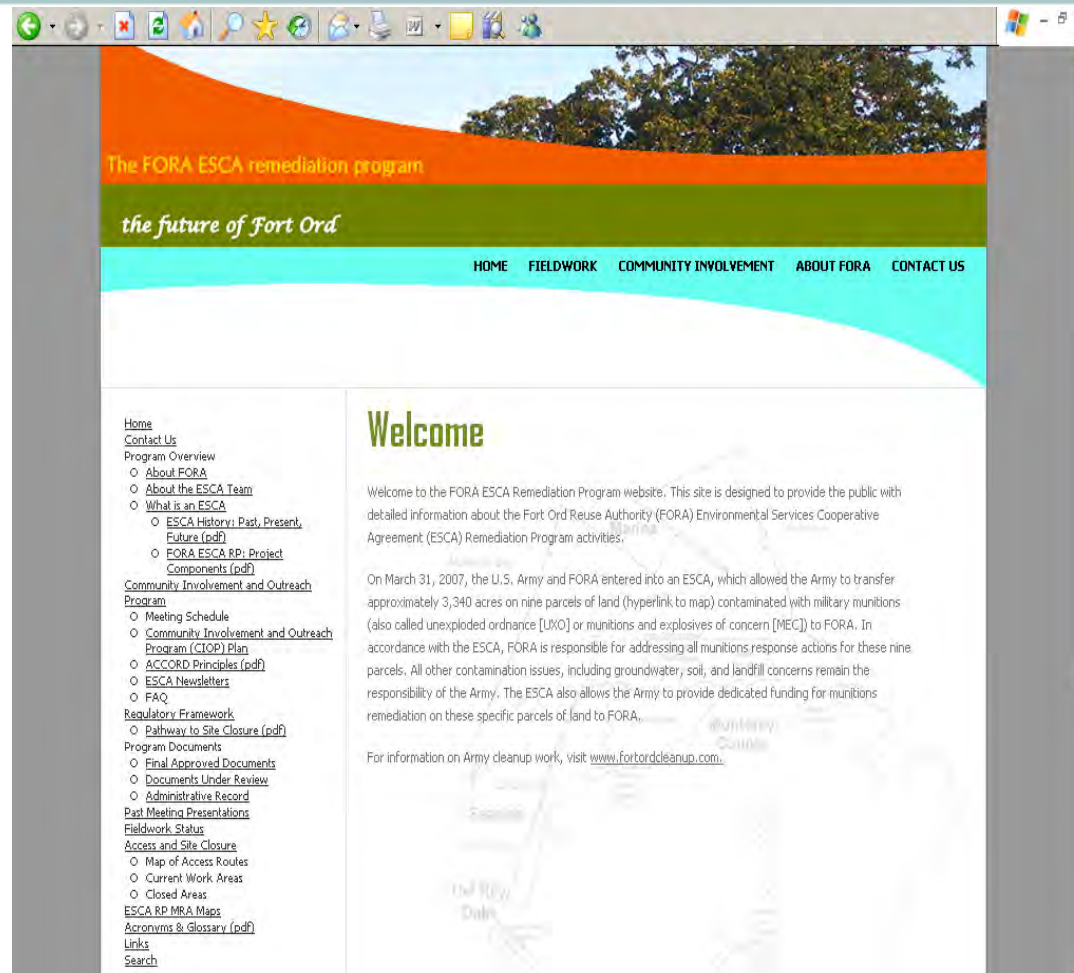
